**Rule 35.1. Reduction of an Imposed Prison Term**

**(a) General.** Except as otherwise ordered by the court or as specified herein, a motion to reduce the term of imprisonment under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) is governed by D.Ak. LCrR 47.1.

**(b) Response/Reply.** In the case of a motion filed by a prisoner appearing through counsel—

(1) the government must serve and file a response not later than thirty (30) days after the motion is served, and

(2) a reply, if any, may be served and filed within seven (7) days after the government has served its response.
