Standard COVID-19 Protocol for Appearing in the Courthouse

- Are you currently diagnosed with COVID-19?
- Are you experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 including: cough, fever, difficulty breathing and or loss of sense of smell or taste?
- Within the last 14 days, have you been in close physical contact with a person who has been diagnosed with COVID-19?
- Within the last 14 days, have you received instructions from a doctor, hospital or public health authority to self-observe, self-isolate or self-quarantine due to possible exposure to COVID-19?

*If your answer to **ANY** of these questions is **YES**, you will **NOT** be allowed to enter the courthouse.*

*If your answer to these questions is **NO**, you may enter the courthouse and follow these guidelines:*

- Visitors are required to wear a face covering or mask at all times while in the courthouse unless a medical condition prevents you from doing so.
- Social Distancing will be observed. Please follow signage on floors, elevators and observe designated seating in the courtrooms.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the court.
- Public access to court hearings is available using the Court's listen-only line. Please visit www.akd.uscourts.gov for information.
