NO. 18-10

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

As a result of the Court closure and slowdown, as well as the disruption for many lawyers, litigants, and witnesses caused by the earthquake, there will be a general extension of some (but not all) normal filing deadlines in the U.S. District Court for the District of Alaska for cases filed in the Anchorage court.

For any non-expedited filing that was or is due from 30 November through 7 December 2018, the new deadline is **11 December 2018**. Any responsive pleading is due the normal time period from 11 December 2018. The parties need not file a motion or stipulation for these extensions.

However, if a response to an expedited filing was or is due from 30 November through 7 December 2018, then the responding party should seek relief from the assigned judge.

This general extension does not apply to deadlines for filings or hearings in Fairbanks or Juneau. **Any request for an extension in a filing or hearing deadline in these cases** must be presented to the assigned judge.
