In order to comply with amendments to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that effective November 27, 2017, the following Local Rules in the District of Alaska are amended.

**Local (Civil) Rule 5.3(f) (2011)** is amended as follows:

**Service.** The filing party must serve all documents being electronically filed upon all persons entitled to service in accordance with otherwise applicable rules.

**Local (Admiralty) Rule e-5(c) (2009)** is amended as follows:

**Tolling of Service Time.** Unless otherwise ordered by the court, in any case in which issuance of process is held in abeyance, the 90-day period of Rule 4(m), Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, will not begin to run until the process is actually issued by the Clerk of Court.

The Clerk of Court is directed to forward a certified copy of this Order to the Judicial Council and the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts as required by 28 U.S.C. § 2071(d).
